WHAT WILL I LEARN?

In this 3-day in-person workshop for <u>8th grade teachers</u>, you will learn how to use a series of <u>web applications</u> and hands-on learning experiences to playfully explore and create sound. The applications, that students love, were created by <u>Victor Minces</u>, a neuroscientist of music and sound artist. The NGSS-aligned curriculum was developed in collaboration with the San Diego County Office of Education. You will leave with a copy of the "<u>Listening to Waves</u>" unit that can be taught to your students this fall.
