Gettin' CRSP! An Introduction to Culturally Responsive-Sustaining Pedagogy

Dr. Michelle Sadrena Pledger is a CSUSM/UCSD JDP alum who is the Director of Liberation at the Center for Research on Equity and Innovation, a center that brings together practitioners, researchers and youth to address complex problems of practice in K-12 education and create more equitable, engaging learning environments for all students.

This workshop shapes the path for teachers to design and deliver culturally responsivesustaining pedagogy. Research indicates that CRSP learning environments result in improvement in attendance, engagement, academic achievement, cross-racial interactions and so much more. Learning about and leveraging the lived experiences of all students into curriculum is critical to whole child classroom integration. Participants will learn how to incorporate cultural competence, critical consciousness, and cognitive capacity development into their lessons, units, and projects.
